

Emerging from a period of huge change...

Getting closer and closer to Universal Access

12% to 91% enrolled in 600 hours per week from 2007-2017.



Increased focus on quality

79% of services in 2019 have a quality rating of meeting the NQS or above.



Sector make up changing

64% of preschool providers offer the program in a LDC setting in 2018, up from 50% in 2013.

In 2018, 42% enrolled in stand alone preschool – down from 55% in 2013. Complex vulnerabilities persist 2018 AEDC found that 1 in 5 children are developmentally vulnerable.
