Over the decade, the Victorian Government is investing almost \$5 billion to deliver funded Three-Year-Old Kindergarten.

Children in 21 local government areas in rural and regional Victoria are now able to access a funded Three-Year-Old Kindergarten program. From 2022, three-year-olds across the rest of the state will have access to five hours of a teacher-led kindergarten program.

This reform will create more than 4,000 new kinder teacher and 2,000 new educator jobs across the state. We need your help to promote careers in early childhood to your community.

Applicants respond well to language that highlights the opportunity to make a difference, the ability to see the difference they make as children grow and learn quickly in the early years, and the opportunity to work in a field that suits their personality, particularly for those who see themselves as nurturing.]

Successful applicants will be supported by a team of educational leaders and offered opportunities for ongoing professional development and training. [Applicants respond strongly to advertisements that showcase the benefits offered as part of their employment. You should promote to applicants any:

3-YEAR-OLD KINDER

- training and development opportunities
- in-service supports (e.g. employee onboarding, pre-service training, study leave)
- professional recognition (e.g. opportunities to progress their career at the service)
- flexibility of work hours and/or days, including non-teaching duties.]

[If your service is located in a regional or rural area, applicants are more incentivised to relocate if a local attraction package is offered (e.g. helping the teacher and their family relocate to the area and join the local community, offering subsidised childcare to those with children and/or selling the location).]

[Service to insert technical details of the position, including qualification requirements, location, number of hours per week (full- or part-time) and workdays of the position, kindergarten setting and the Agreement or Award that applies to the position.]

There is more demand than ever for bachelor-qualified teachers to deliver Three-Year-Old Kindergarten so there's no better time to enrol in a bachelor degree to become an early childhood teacher.

There are hundreds of financial support packages available now to upskill by studying to become an early childhood teacher. Eligible recipients could receive up to \$34,000 towards an approved bachelor qualification or up to \$24,000 towards an approved postgraduate qualification.

You may also be eligible to apply for the accelerated Bachelor of Early Childhood Education program through Deakin University. This program is available for up to 76 participants and provided a supported, employment-based pathway to become an early childhood teacher in 18-months – helping you to continue to work while you learn.

Training to become an early childhood educator is a great way to establish a meaningful career working to support children's learning and development at a pivotal time in their lives.
