Victorian visa nomination for skilled migrants – We can support you to make Victoria home

Victoria offers skilled migrants diverse career opportunities and an exceptional quality of life.

Melbourne, the capital of Victoria, consistently ranks among the world's most liveable cities and is renowned for its cosmopolitan culture, welcoming communities, world-class education and healthcare services. Victoria's robust economy offers a wide range of career opportunities along with work-life balance that ranks among the best globally. From vibrant arts and culture to clean, green outdoors to stunning coastlines and national parks, there is so much to discover in Victoria.

The Victorian Government supports skilled migrants seeking to live and work in Victoria by providing free visa nomination.



What is skilled visa nomination?

Visa nomination from a state or territory government is a mandatory requirement for the skilled nominated visa (subclass 190) and the skilled work regional visa (subclass 491).

The Victorian Government offers visa nomination to skilled migrants with skill sets that can make a significant contribution to the Victorian economy and the global competitiveness of our industries.

When a state or territory government nominates you for a skilled visa, it indicates to the Australian Government's Department of Home Affairs that your skills are needed in their region.

Victoria's visa nomination program:

- ✓ Adds 5 points to your overall Australian visa application points test.
- ✓ Is entirely cost-free.
- ✓ Does not require a job or employer sponsorship.
- ✓ Provides unrestricted work rights in accordance with visa conditions.
- ✓ Offers pathway to permanent residency.

Skilled Visa Nomination

The Victorian Government provides skilled visa nomination for the following visas:

Skilled Nominated Visa (subclass 190)

This is a permanent visa that allows skilled migrants to reside and work anywhere within Victoria, including Melbourne.

Skilled Regional (Provisional) Visa (subclass 491)

This is a five-year provisional visa for living and working in regional Victoria, with a pathway to permanent residency.

Both pathways:

- ✓ Do not require you to have employment in Victoria before you arrive.

Am I eligible?

To apply for Victorian skilled visa nomination, you must meet the following criteria:

- ▼ Achieve a minimum of **65 points** on the Australian Government’s points test for your Expression of Interest (EOI) in SkillSelect
- ▼ Have a valid **Skills Assessment** in an occupation listed on the **eligible skilled occupations list**
- ▼ Have at least **Competent English** proficiency
- ▼ Have your **Registration of Interest (ROI)** selected by the Victorian Government
- ▼ Be under 45 years of age
- ▼ Be committed to living in Victoria

You’ll need a valid Skills Assessment and English test before applying.
